The Grand Marais Recreation Area is a municipal park with the premiere campground and marina on Lake Superior, next to the harbor of downtown Grand Marais. The location is regionally significant for its full-service RV park, campground and marina on the north shore of Lake Superior. One-of-a-kind, natural and cultural experiences are easily accessible by visitors to the Lake Superior cobblestone beaches, rugged break walls and coastal wetlands onsite. Signature features further enhancing the site include: Sweethearts Bluff Nature Area with hiking trails, the local historical society's interpretive Fish Museum, harbor side pavilion and picnic areas, a rec. hall, playground, ball field, community garden, public water access ramps, connectivity to the Gitchi-Gami state bike trail and unlimited smooth stones for skipping the calm water of the Grand Marais harbor. The property is an in-town treasure and highly sought after regional tourist destination for campers and boaters. The recreation area is footsteps away from Grand Marais and all its natural, cultural, historic and harbor side charms.

### Overview/Description of Park or Trail

The Grand Marais Recreation Area is the municipal park, campground and marina on Lake Superior and the harbor of Grand Marais. Approximately 80 acres of public parkland are framed by roughly a mile of Lake Superior shoreline, including coastal wetlands, rugged break walls and cobblestone beaches. The location is accessible via State Highway 61, DNR Lake Superior Water Trail and the Gitchi-Gami state bike trail. The

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City of Grand Marais and Minnesota Land Trust hold a conservation easement on the property to protect the natural and scenic values of the land. The marina has been a member of the Minnesota Clean Marina organization since the group's inception in 2013.

For generations, Grand Marais has hosted vacationers and adventurers seeking a truly unique, Minnesota experience on the shores of the largest freshwater lake in the world. The harbor town has a sense of place like no other. In Grand Marais, unique topography, weather and natural resources combine with a rich history of settlement, industry, arts and recreation to create a culture of true regional significance. The Grand Marais Recreation Area offers visitors access to the abundant historical, cultural and natural resources of Grand Marais, Lake Superior and the adjacent inland wilderness.

The 300 site campground and 30 slip marina hosts approximately 20,000 visitors annually as overnight guests. Additionally, thousands of day users enjoy the parkland and lake shore for rest and rejuvenation, rock skipping, picnicking, walking, birding, hiking, biking, paddling, fishing, sailing, power boating and socializing. The recreation area includes Sweetheart's Bluff Nature Area with walking trails, including the barrier-free access Lake Loop. The historical society have an interpretive Fish Museum onsite. Grand Marais' regional appeal resonates throughout the park's public spaces, on the waterfront, that host community events, recreation and family vacations.

The campground features a full spectrum of site types across a 300 total site count; 161 are electric/water/sewer, 82 electric/water, and 57 primitive. The marina provides 30 slips, 9 mooring balls, service dock with fuel and pump-out and 3 public boat launches. Recreation area facilities accommodate guests with four, modern bathhouses, RV dump station, fish cleaning station, picnic pavilion, recreation hall, playground, ball field and community garden. A park office headquarters onsite, and is staffed year-round by the Grand Marais Parks Department.

The Grand Marais Recreation Area is the largest municipal park, campground and marina on the north shore of Minnesota. Grand Marais is the eastern gateway to the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness and Superior National Forest via the historic Gunflint Trail. The town is also within 70 miles of all 8 state parks on the shore. The marina is an oasis along a 90 mile stretch between Sliver Bay and Grand Portage, and a welcome stop for cruisers from the Apostles Islands, en route to Isle Royale. The Grand Marais Recreation Area is the base camp for exploring Minnesota's arrowhead - a region full of the state's best natural resources, recreation, arts, culture and history.

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area offers more than just public access to Lake Superior. The location is undoubtedly one of the best spots on Lake Superior for tourists to visit - the cobblestone beach and harbor of Grand Marais. The in-town convenience for campers to experience roughing it, yet still order a Sven and 'Ole's pizza delivered to their site is a real charm, especially for families. So too is the ability to walk the cobblestone beaches and skip rocks on the big lake. Many loyal guests mention Grand Marais campground as their favorite spot, and returning families have been coming for 50+ years to the recreation area. Being surrounded by stunning views of Lake Superior and the Sawtooth Mountains, next to downtown Grand Marais, is what makes this recreation area so significant.

The facilities for camping feature a full-spectrum of services, from rustic tent to big-rig friendly, pull-thru, 50 Amp/water/sewer sites. A 300 site count reflects the vast scale of selections and settings. All sites are within walking distance to Lake Superior. The marina offers full service fuel dock and sanitary pump-out, in addition to slips and moorings in the harbor. Four, modern bath houses serve guest's needs - the newest of which includes a state-of-the-art solar hot water system. The city takes pride in the operations, leading a highly successful team of year-round and seasonal workers who maintain the facilities and grounds. The location is prime and the demand to visit insatiable. Naturally, the recreation area is kept safe, clean and welcoming.

**Provides a Natural and Scenic Setting Offering a Compelling Sense of Place**

The scenery surrounding the recreation area features the best of the north shore - Grand Marais' lighthouse, breakwalls and harbor, the endless horizon of Lake Superior, the long look down the Sawtooth Mountain Ridges and the bluffed ridge line above town. Visitors to the recreation area are immersed in the natural beauty of water meeting woods, especially in the adjoining nature area, Sweetheart's Bluff, featuring the barrier-free access Lake Loop trail. Cobblestone beaches of Lake Superior and Grand Marais' harbor provide unlimited, smooth stones for skipping and infinite waves lapping the shoreline. The location has always appealed to vacationers. The history of the campground hosting tourist can be traced back to the dawn of RVs in the 1940s. Original settlement of the region has even deeper roots around the natural harbor. Throughout the 1950s into the 1980s, the campground was called the Tourist Park, a moniker that lives on to this day and honors the tradition and significance of serving the needs of tourists.

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Grand Marais' rich history, diverse culture, spectacular scenery, and tourist friendly services create a must-stop experience for Lake Superior travelers. The recreation area gives visitors full immersion into the unique sense of place found only in Grand Marais. Visitors to the park need not go far to experience north shore history. The Cook County Historical Society showcase a Fish Museum with historically accurate, recreated fish house, original smoke house and partially restored herring tug onsite, in the marina. The original lighthouse keepers quarters serves as the society's headquarters/museum, and is minutes from the park by foot. In 1996 the city recognized the unique natural and scenic qualities of the recreation area and entered a conservation easement with the Minnesota Land Trust. Annual monitoring visits by this agency ensures perpetual resource protection and land stewardship.

**Well-located to Serve a Regional Need and/or Tourist Destination**

The Lake Superior harbor village of Grand Marais is a top tourist destination regionally, and the Grand Marais Recreation Area provides the adjacent base camp for tens of thousands of visitors annually. The 300 site campground and 30 slip marina is a major anchor in Cook County, where 80% of the economy is tourism based. Lodging tax generated from the campground accounts for nearly 10% of the total collected in the district. Vehicle access is directly off scenic Highway 61, an all American Road. The Grand Marais section of the Gitchi-Gami state bike trail runs through the property, merging with the park's "Community Connection" for barrier free access, complete with a covered, timber framed bridge built by local students at the North House Folk School next door. The location also serves Big Lake explorers with a designated campsite on the DNR Lake Superior Water Trail and full service marina with public access boat launches.

Grand Marais is the eastern gateway to the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness and Superior National Forest, via the Gunflint Trail, which begins right across the street from the park. Adventurers rely on the recreation area for staging visits to and from inland wilderness, lakes and forests. The Gunflint Ranger station is within one mile of the park. All 8 state parks on the north shore are within 70 miles for day trips. Pincushion Mountain, a USFS recreation area, features access to the Superior Hiking Trail, mountain biking and xc ski trails, and is 3 miles from the park on the ridge line above town. 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Recreation Area is much more than the ideal location to stay and play on the north shore, for the year round residents of Grand Marais, it is a coastal neighborhood like no other and beloved public park.

**Fills a Gap in Recreational Opportunity within the Region**

The demand for access to Lake Superior on Minnesota's north shore is tremendous. The recreation area's lakeside campground, along with other campgrounds on the shore consistently track nearly full occupancy rates during the busy summer months. However, no other campground in the region compares in size, scale, campsite variety, and support services to the Grand Marais Recreation Area. Unlike regional state parks and forest service campgrounds where RV size and utilities are limited, the needs of larger RVs are met at the recreation area. Another key distinction of camping in Grand Marais is the in-town convenience of setting-up and strolling around the harbor to downtown shops, galleries, restaurants and attractions.

The Grand Marais Recreation Area is home to one of few marinas on Minnesota's north shore of Lake Superior. The Minnesota Clean Marina facility prides itself on protecting resources and providing fuel, sanitary pump-out, slips, buoys and public water access. The harbor of Grand Marais is a natural refuge along Minnesota's cold, rocky shoreline. The next closest marinas are Silver Bay and Grand Portage, both roughly 50 miles away, (a distance of 10 hours by sailboat). The marina is the preferred port for cruising boats transiting from the Apostles Islands (60 miles south) to Isle Royale (60 miles east).

Additional, unique support services at the recreation area for regional visitors include: RV dump station, fish cleaning station, showers for non-guests and electric vehicle charging stations - significant services for users of inland, national forest campgrounds and Lake Superior Circle Tour travelers. Facilities for hosting events, managed by the park are the harbor side picnic pavilion, recreation hall, and downtown's Boulder and Harbor Park. More recently, the in-town location has proven ideal for students of the North House Folk School and Grand Marais Art Colony seeking affordable lodging options.
