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Purpose

The Greater Minnesota Regional Parks and Trails Commission (GMRPTC) is evaluating the mountain bike trail system in Northern Minnesota, specifically as it relates to trails within Districts 1 and 2. The sport continues to increase in popularity and the demand for purpose built, sustainable trails has compelled GMRPTC to complete a system inventory.

GMPRTC intends to ascertain these characteristics:

- 1. What trails and amenities exist and what are proposed to be built?
- 2. What, if any, additional trails are needed to serve the regional population as well as the influx of riders to the area.
- 3. What does the system, as it exists now, look like with the inclusion of not only designated trails, but local trail connections?
- 4. What are the total miles of trails within the districts and what are the difficulty levels?

The information is a snapshot in time. There are several trails which are actively being constructed and mountain bike opportunities are being added to existing trails. The information has been gathered to assist land managers, trail developers, and the Commission understand the size and scope of the current mountain bike trail system in the northern portion of Minnesota. This information may be updated, or other district mountain bike trail information may be inventoried as future projects. The information is not designed to be used as navigation for trail enthusiasts.

Summary

UP! Outside (UP) was selected by the Greater Minnesota Regional Parks and Trails Commission (GMRPTC) to determine what opportunities exist or have been proposed within GMRPTC Districts 1 and 2. This area consists of 24 counties and is generally the upper third of the State of Minnesota.

For this project, a mountain bike trail is defined as a natural surface trail, such as dirt, grass, or gravel, which allowed mountain bike use. Paved and asphalt trails are not included, nor are trails which solely allowed fat-tire bikes. A trail is defined as a route with a specific starting and end


location with a unique name. There are no mileage minimum or maximums for a route to be considered a trail. A trail system is defined as a single or group of trails in a specific area. The groupings are determined by the land managers or trail coordinators. The Duluth Traverse trail system is a two-tiered system with six sets of subgroupings within the full Duluth Traverse system. Land managers are government agency personnel who have management of public land and recreational opportunities included in their job duties. A purpose-built trail is a trail designed primarily for mountain bike use. Some purpose-built trails have brought in experts or accessed the expertise of local mountain bike riders. A purpose-built trail may or may not allow other uses. A trail which was created for another use, then converted to mountain bike use is not considered purpose built.

To locate the trails, UP queried government agencies, counties, cities, townships, enthusiast groups, economic development, and other groups which could have information about the trails. UP found several websites that listed mountain bike trails throughout the State as well as difficulty levels and



personal perspective information. The trails were imported into a series of maps. All information was reviewed for accuracy before being incorporated into the final documentation. No on-site verification was conducted for this inventory, however direct contact was made to clarify data wherever possible.

There are a total of 26 existing and proposed trail systems within GMRPTC Districts 1 and 2 when the Duluth Traverse is counted as one system. The maps and accompanying table break the Duluth Traverse into six separate units according to the trail locations. The mountain bike trail systems ranged from one trail to the 81 trails which currently make up the Duluth Traverse system.



The trails were listed according to a difficulty level of Easy, Moderate, or Difficult. This rating was consistent across all sources of information with generally just the names of the categories changing. One source listed two levels of 'Difficult' as Black Diamond and Double Black Diamond. These trails are all listed as 'Difficult' in this report to keep consistency between the sources. Proposed trails were rated when the information was known, but they cannot be confirmed until constructed.

The charts below show the number of trails and the number of miles of trail by difficulty level. The charts in figures 1 and 2 show there are a higher number of Moderate trails, but there are more

miles of Easy trails than any other level. The higher mileage Easy trails can be attributed to Rail Trails (former railroad beds converted to trails) which allow mountain bikes.





Definitions

For this project, a mountain bike trail is defined as a natural surface trail, such as dirt, grass, or gravel, which allowed mountain bike use. Paved and asphalt trails are not included, nor are trails which solely allowed fat-tire bikes. A trail is defined as a route with a specific starting and end location with a unique name. There are no mileage minimum or maximums for a route to be considered a trail. A trail system is defined as a single or group of trails in a specific area. The groupings are determined by the land managers or trail coordinators. The Duluth Traverse trail system is a twotiered system with six sets of subgroupings within the full Duluth Traverse system. Land managers are government agency personnel who have management of public land and recreational opportunities included in their job




duties. A purpose-built trail is a trail designed primarily for mountain bike use. Some purpose-built trails have brought in experts or accessed the expertise of local mountain bike riders. A purpose-built trail may or may not allow other uses. A trail which was created for another use, then converted to mountain bike use is not considered purpose built.

Sources

The primary sources of information were land managers. Generally, land managers are the MN

Land managers are government agency personnel who have management of public land and recreational opportunities included in their job duties.

DNR, the US Forest Service, and counties. Some of the trails are located on land owned by other entities, such as a city. No trails listed are located on private property. All the counties were contacted to obtain mountain bike trail information. The counties often referred UP to other sources, such as cities, townships, and clubs. All leads were researched to a conclusion of receiving the trail information, the proposed trail information, or confirmation that a suggested trail did not exist or was not designated.



There are several websites which contain mountain bike trail information. TrailLink is a website which has been created by the Rails-To-Trails Conservancy, a non-profit which helps organizations convert unused railroad beds into trails. Rail Trails are wide, flat trails which can be paved or remain as natural surface.

The other websites contain trail information uploaded by the site users. This type of information gathering is called crowdsourcing. Crowdsourcing can be an excellent way of locating trails, however, it doesn't include any due diligence that the trails listed on the site are, in fact, trails designated for that purpose. Before trails identified from crowdsourcing websites were included in the final list, UP researched the trails to ensure they were designated for mountain bike use by the land manager.

A mountain bike trail is defined as a natural surface trail, such as dirt, grass, or gravel, which allowed mountain bike use.

The full list of trails used for this report and located on the maps is in Appendix A: Trail Attributes Chart.

Undesignated Trails

There were several other types of trails and trail systems that were found in the crowdsourcing websites. This data was initially captured and added to the trail system spread sheet. While researching the trail designations and trail uses published

by the land managers, non-mountain bike trails were removed from the inventory list as undesignated trails.

These trails include:

• Grant-in-Aid snowmobile or off-highway vehicle trails in Lake, Carlton, and St Louis counties


- Paved trails in St Louis, Lake, and Koochiching counties
- Unverified trails in St Louis, Lake, and Itasca counties

A trail system is defined as a single or group of trails in a specific area.

- Trails in the US National Forests of Chippewa and Superior National Forests that are not designated for mountain bike use
- Trails in Minnesota State Parks that are not designated for mountain bike use
- Cross-country ski trails

The Taconite and Arrowhead Trails are MN DNR snowmobile trails in the Grant-In-Aid system. Maps for these trails indicate mountain biking is allowed on these trails, however, there are no defined mountain bikes routes shown. UP staff contacted MN DNR Parks and Trails office which

oversees these 2 trails to determine which segments of the trails are open to mountain biking. There are no officially designated portions of these trails open to mountain biking, therefore, neither the Taconite nor the Arrowhead trails were listed in the trail inventory.



Results

Trail Systems

In GMRPTC Districts 1 and 2, UP located 26 trail systems. These range from the Minnesota Mosey (one trail of 1.8 miles) to the full Duluth Traverse system which currently consists of six sections, 81 trails, and 94 trail miles. There were two trails, the Agassiz and the Hidden Valley systems, which crossed county lines. All other trail systems are within a single county.

Figure 3: Regionally designated mountain bike trails per District




Figure 4: Number of Trail Miles per County

Trail Difficulty Levels

One goal of a State-wide system of trails is to provide a variety of difficulty levels. In general, the ideal system will have some Easy and Difficult trails and a higher percentage of Moderate trail

difficulty. The reasoning behind the spread is that most trail enthusiasts have a moderate skill level regardless of the type of trail activity. There needs to be sufficient opportunities to learn the sport, which requires Easy trails and skills building areas. The dedicated trail enthusiasts have a higher skill level and desire more challenge in the trails.



There is a wide range of difficulty levels by system within Districts 1 and 2. The majority of trails are in the Moderate difficulty level. The greatest number of miles of trails are in the Easy difficulty level.



Trail Types

Out of the 245 trails, only 68 were purpose-built, designated only for mountain bikes, and are currently open for use. There are an additional 26 trails which were purpose-built mountain bike trails that are currently open for use by mountain bike riders plus at least one other additional use.

The trail systems which include purpose-built trails are:

- Cuyuna State Recreation Area
- Britton Peak
- Duluth Traverse
- Legion
- Milaca
- Movil Maze
- Pincushion Mountain
- Roseau Borud

Additional, purpose-built mountain bike trails are being proposed or are in the construction process at these trail systems:



All the other trails are multi-use trails with at least one additional use for the trail. Most trail sharing includes mountain bikes and hiking. This is in large part due to the Duluth Traverse being designated for those uses. More trails allow mountain biking, hiking, and other uses. Some trail systems only allow mountain biking and either fat tire biking or cross-country skiing. Figures 12 and 13 indicate the trails open to additional uses

Most of the trails that had use in addition to mountain biking were open during the summer months only. There were a few trails that were shared by cross-country skiing only, a winter activity. Several trails had additional activities in both winter and summer, allowing the trails to remain open year-round. Figure 14 shows the season of the additional use for the multi-use trails.

Trail Facilities

All the existing trail systems had either a trailhead or parking area, as part of the trail system or directly adjacent to the system. Only the Milaca Trails and the Roseau Borud trails listed parking as the only facility offered to trail users. Remaining trail systems had one or more additional attributes ranging from overlooks and shelters, to the facilities included within State Parks and National Forests. Each system has its own list of features indicated in the Trail Attributes Chart listed in Appendix A.

The surface of most of the trail systems was listed as 'natural surface'. A few trails were listed as gravel. A few were noted as grass or dirt surfaces. The list of trail surfaces is indicated in the Trail Attributes Chart listed in Appendix A.
